1. Number of posts may increase or decrease as per requirement.

For JR post Candidate must possess a minimum qualification of MBBS from a Institute/University recognized by State/Central Govt. as in this current era of CORONA Pandemic, MBBS doctors recruited in any department will be required to work in COVID DEDICATED WARDS to make up the shortfall of requisite number of Medical Officers. MD/MS candidates will be given preference.
3. Selection for JR posts will be on Urgent Temporary Basis for 06 months only.
4. Candidates need to produce NOC (No Objection Certificate) from present employer at the time of interview as per RajMES rules. Selected candidates need to produce Relieving order at the time of joining as per society rules.
5. Candidate need to submit affidavit on stamp paper of minimum value Rs 100 at the time of joining in the prescribed proforma. (Annexure-1 for JR post)
6. No TA/DA will be given for the interview.

8. Selected candidates will be given consolidated salary i.e. Rs. 61300/- per month for Junior Resident post, as per Rajasthan Medical Education Society rules.
